

- to export your data in the appropriate format to be analyzed.




1. Contract Portfolio

Within the Clients menu, you will have access to the list of your clients' contracts.



Through a simple **search box**, you will be able to locate your client using:

- the contract number.
- the name of the company or
- the name of the CGS Client



You can also locate the contract through the **full list of contracts**, where we will provide you with the name customer, contract number, end date and the loss ratio.

Using the icon \uparrow , you can mark the contract as favorite, and then it will appear by default within 5 main contracts on the home page.

To access the details of each contract, click on the display icon () located in the last column from the table.



Data export

You can download the complete list of contracts through the drop-down that you'll find at the top of the table.

You can also select each contract individually by marking the first column.


Contract details can be displayed by clicking on the

Provides you with claims data over the past 3 insurance periods.

Acceptance rate

Provides you with a graph of comparison for the current and last 3 months as well as 2 years prior. In addition, you can export this data to excel.



CONTRACT INFORMATION / DETAILS OF THE CLIENT

In addition to the acceptance rate and the loss ratio, you can access basic information of the contract:

- Inception date, current duration and insurance period
- Currency (ZAR)
- Premium invoiced in the insurance period
- Minimum premium
- Premium rates
- Maximum Credit Period (MCP)
- Notification of Overdue Account
- Maximum Liability

LOSS RATIO DETAILS

This provides you with details of the loss ratio, and you are able to view in a graph format or excel table.

In this tab, you can view:


- the insurance period

Net Premium






2. CGS Client Portfolio

Use the search box to easily find your CGS client.




The following data can be reviewed:

It is a brilliant tool that allows you access to all credit decisions on your clients.


The filters can be used to custmize your search as per your needs.

You can also export the data to excel.







Within the Clients menu, you will have access to a list of claims submitted.





Similar to the risk feature, it allows you access to all claims notifications.

Export data


You are able to view the list of claims filtered to a specific country and buyer. Data can also be exported for ease of management.


If you click on the icon it will display the company details, only for export countries due to POPIA. South African companies' information is confidential.


CLIENTS 5. Activity

Within the Clients menu, you will have access to the activity tab.




This allows you access to newly signed contracts and cancelled contracts.
